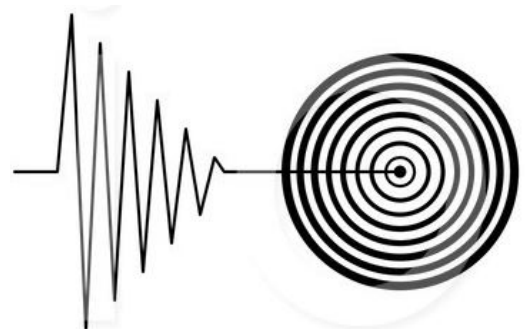

West Hollywood takes a proactive approach to earthquake safety. Our goal is to help protect people and minimize damage in the event of a major earthquake.

The City is developing a mandatory Seismic Retrofit ordinance intended at strengthening existing Non-Ductile Concrete and older Steel Moment Frame Buildings. Historically, these buildings have not performed well during major seismic events. The ordinance will be considered by the West Hollywood City Council.

We encourage you to attend a Community Meeting to share your thoughts and ideas.

While no building is absolutely earthquake-proof, retrofitting existing buildings will help protect buildings and the safety of people in them.
