

RESOLUTION NO. 18-5136

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD AMENDING THE BALLOT QUESTION IN RESOLUTIONS 18-5131, 18-5132, AND 18-5133, RELATING TO THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2019.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. On November 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-5131, calling and giving notice of the holding of a general municipal election on March 5, 2019 for the submission to the voters a question relating to a referendum challenging West Hollywood Resolution No. 18-5104, amending the General Plan Land Use Map in conjunction with a proposed development located at 8920 Sunset Blvd.

SECTION 2. On November 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-5132, setting priorities for filing written arguments regarding the ballot measure described in Section 1 above.

SECTION 3. On November 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-5133, providing for the filing of rebuttal arguments for the ballot measure described in Section 1 above.

SECTION 4. The ballot question set forth in Section 4 of Resolution No. 18-5131 and Section 1 of Resolutions 18-5132 and 18-5133 is amended to read as follows:


