NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Community Development Department of the City of West Hollywood has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration concerning:

A proposed automated parking garage at City Hall, located at **8300 Santa Monica Boulevard**, West Hollywood, California. (General Plan Consistency 2011-002)

Pursuant to Section 17702 of the California Environmental Quality Act, this is not on any of the lists enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Pursuant to the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act, the Lead Agency has analyzed the project and determined that the project will NOT have a significant impact on the environment. Based on this finding the Lead Agency has prepared this MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION.

Beginning on Thursday, October 20, 2011, a minimum period of no less than twenty-one (21) days will be provided to enable public review of the project specifications, the Initial Study and this document prior to final adoption of the MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION by the Lead Agency. **The review period has been extended to Thursday, May 3, 2012 at 5:00 pm.**

On or after Thursday, May 3, 2012, the Planning Commission will make a decision regarding this application. The Mitigated Negative Declaration will be available for public review at the Community Development Department at 8300 Santa Monica Boulevard, West Hollywood, CA 90069, beginning October 20, 2011.
